## HVAC Service Technician:

This job involves troubleshooting, diagnosing, repair, installation, servicing and maintenance of heating, air conditioning and refrigeration systems found in commercial buildings, hospitals, and supermarkets, industrial and manufacturing plants. This job requires climbing, bending, stooping, crawling, kneeling, lifting and working in extreme temperature ranges. You may be required to work in high or enclosed spaces, and outside in various weather conditions.

Service fitters must have a good understanding of electricity, refrigeration, heat transfer, and temperature control. Applicants must successfully complete a two-year day school course in HVAC/R prior to applying for the service apprenticeship program.
